Ability to Work

- Pursuant to Charter §A8.511(c), a retiree may work up to 960 hours per fiscal year without having to reinstate and forfeit their pension benefit. This applies both to employees that elected a service retirement and those that elected a vested retirement.
- Employees that retire must be off payroll for 60 days post-retirement before they can comeback as a retiree. However, this rule does not apply to miscellaneous employees that retire at age 62 or higher or safety employees that retire at age 50 or higher.



Benefits

- Do not receive health or retirement benefits as an active employee as receive these benefits as a retiree.
- Only paid for hours worked (i.e., receive no form paid leave including sick leave).
