4020-06/07	70	General Services Agency	Regular	\$95,000	\$195,000	The City's Sweatfree Contracting Ordinance (Administrative Code Section 12U) authorizes OLSE to monitor contractors' compliance with the Ordinance. This extension of the PSC duration and adding funds are requested because the contract monitoring was delayed. The Ordinance provides that until such time as the City determines that it is able to adequately monitor compliance using city personnel, the City shall enter into a professional services contract with an independent non profit organization for assistance in monitoring compliance. The vendor will monitor compliance by contractors located outside the Bay Area and abroad (e.g. Mexico, India, China, Dominican Republic and other foreign countries), that provide goods to the City.
