Under general supervisions performs skilled electrical work in connection with the <u>installation</u>, maintenance, repair and alterations of electrical systems <u>under 600 volts</u>, machinery and equipment; may exercise work direction over craftsmen <del>helpers</del> involved in such work; and performs related duties as required.

Requires responsibility for: <a href="mailto:print-reading.">print reading.</a> installing, maintaining, testing explaining and earrying out methods and procedures relative to electrical maintenance and repairing electrical equipment; inspecting and repairing generating equipment; cutting, bending and installing rigid conduit, electrical metallic tubing (EMT) and pulling conductors; setting up and using ladders, staging, aerial lift trucks and light towers, and use of personal protective equipment (PPE). May involve work with high voltage (277 Volt - 480 Volt) equipment and installation, maintenance, testing and repair of traffic signal equipment.; preparing routine reports of work accomplished and time expended on maintenance and repair activities. Nature of work involves: some physical effort and dexterity in the use of fingers, limbs and body; continuous exposure to <a href="mailto:hazardous environments">hazardous environments</a> physical and working conditions where minor-injuries may be encountered.

#### MAJOR, IMPORTANT, AND ESSENTIAL DUTIES

According to Civil Service Commission Rule 109, the duties specified below are representative of the range of duties assigned to this job code/class and are not intended to be an inclusive list.

Performs electrician duties in connection with a wide variety of building alterations, maintenance and repair projects and other appurtenant and miscellaneous structures; linstalls, maintains, tests and repairs electrical distribution systems and devices -such as lighting, and power circuits, fixtures, transformers, programmable logical controls (PLC), motors, motor controls, process controls, auxiliary lighting systems, life safety systems, electronic controls, relays, regulators, branch circuit breakers, main distribution circuit breakers, irrigation control systems, and other related electrical equipment which may be in confined spaces.
- 2. Makes linspections and repairs of generating equipment and UPS (uninterrupted power supply) and its auxiliary accessories appurtenances.
- 3. <u>Cuts, bends and installs rigid conduit, electrical metallic tubing (EMT) and pulls current carrying conductors</u> Maintains, adjusts and repairs circuit breakers and related operating equipment.

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4. Tests and repairs various types of relays and regulators.
