



Response to Questions from Candidates

1. Question. The dress code (pg 31) says station uniform is an option. Some officers wear different uniforms (specialized) and uniforms have names and star numbers as identification on them. This may include weapons on the belt of the uniform as we are required to have certain items with us when in uniform. Can you please clarify what station uniform means? This does not sound impartial, or correct. The last exam did not allow uniforms, after a review of this same situation.
 - a. IOS Response. The attire for each day of the assessment will require all candidates to be in business professional attire. As mentioned in the question above, station uniforms are not consistent across all candidates and thus cannot be worn for the assessments. You must arrive in business professional attire on each day of your upcoming assessment.

2. Question. Will we be given arrival times, or will there be a follow up notice given on when to “sign-up” for the arrival time?
 - a. IOS Response. The Department of Human Resources – Public Safety Team emailed a Self-Scheduling Exam Notice on November 30, 2019. An email confirming your arrival times for both exam days will be sent along with other exam information no later than December 10, 2019.

3. Question. How much blank paper will be given during the preparation period? Will there be extra blank paper available during the preparation period?
 - a. IOS Response. Included with your exercise instructions will be 6 pages of bond paper for you to use to take notes in preparation for the exercises. You may take any notes with you to the exercises. If you need additional paper during the preparation time, raise your hand to alert a proctor.
