GENDER INCLUSION POLICY

The Gender Inclusion Policy means:

- You can use your chosen name and pronouns at work, including on your ID badge.
- Your managers and coworkers must use your chosen name and pronouns.
- You can express your gender through your appearance and attire in alignment with your department's dress code.
- You can use bathrooms and gender-specific facilities that match your gender identity.

All employees, applicants, and contractors must be treated with dignity and respect, regardless of gender, gender identity, and gender expression.

• You decide when, how, and to whom you will disclose personal information about your gender identity.
